





Dennis Gregory



When former Fairleigh Dickinson basketball coach Tom Green heard that Sonny Vaccaro was shopping for a permanent home for his renowned ABCD summer basketball camp in the mid-1990s he knew exactly who to turn to in his efforts to lure the event to the Rothman Center on the Hackensack campus.

Dennis Gregory had served as an assistant coach to Green at FDU from 1985-87, but it was more than that. Gregory had a knack for getting things done. And he knew the sport.

“He was synonymous with basketball,” Green said of Gregory.

Following an itinerant existence over its first 10 years, the prestigious ABCD camp, which annually featured the nation’s top high school talent, became a fixture on the FDU campus from 1994 until its final July session in 2006. Green, the winningest coach in FDU history, knows why.

“Dennis was very instrumental in helping us get the deal together to bring the ABCD camp to FDU,” said Green.

“The impact he had on New Jersey’s basketball landscape is indelible.”



Gregory, who passed away on Dec. 29, 2018 at the age of 55, had a unique ability to make things happen no matter what role he was in. He was part basketball coach, part administrator, managed basketball facilities, worked in a sports marketing firm and founded the Metro Classic, which brought together the top teams in the Metropolitan Area every summer, serving as a precursor of what to expect when the high school season began.

And his life always involved basketball in some way, shape or form.

He will be remembered, fittingly enough, through the annual Dennis Gregory Memorial Classic, an event featuring high school games that will benefit the Dennis Gregory Memorial Fund. The fund will provide programming and scholarships for deserving students from kindergarten through sixth grade in the game he loved.

“All of my memories of Dennis are every place there was something basketball-related going on in New Jersey,” said Bob Hurley, Sr., the Hall of Fame basketball coach at St. Anthony High School in Jersey City. “When he started the Metro Classic and then ran it you knew which teams would be favored to win in New York and New Jersey that year. Everyone went. You saw in a matter of days every matchup you could dream of as a basketball fan.

“It had more luster than your regular-season high school games. It was in July, so the place filled with college coaches. If you finished in the top three in the Metro Classic you knew you had a chance to go on to a championship high school season.”

Gregory would start on a lifetime path of basketball by working with the CYO league in his hometown of Rutherford early on. He became the head basketball coach at Don Bosco Prep in Ramsey, then was the head coach at Queen of Peace High School in North Arlington.



He served as an assistant to Green for three years, then was director of the Rothman Center from 1987-95, overseeing the ABCD Camp and starting the Metro Classic. He then moved on to be an assistant athletic director at FDU-Teaneck for nine years and also worked as executive vice president of marketing and promotion for the Hoop Group.



It was back to courtside after that, with Gregory becoming an assistant basketball coach at Caldwell College for a year before then-Rutgers basketball head coach Fred Hill hired him as Director of Basketball Operations from 2006-2010.



“We had the best-run basketball program in the country at the time, and Dennis was the reason for that,” Hill said.



Following his Rutgers stint, Gregory became an assistant athletic director at Caldwell College in 2014, staying in that capacity until his death.

Todd Palmer, who played for Gregory at Don Bosco Prep and left as the school’s career scoring leader before going on to play at Notre Dame, said he is forever grateful for the way Gregory helped steer him through a stellar high school career and then a pressure-filled recruiting process.



“Dennis was heavily involved in the whole recruiting process,” said Palmer. “I can’t thank Dennis enough for what he did for me. Along with my parents, he was instrumental in me attending Don Bosco and then Notre Dame. Basketball was his life. I met so many people in the world of hoops and athletics through Dennis.”

Green still marvels at Gregory’s ability to make things happen in a sport where egos often clash. “Dennis was a master of everything – and he knew basketball,” Green said. “When I first hired him, I didn’t know if he knew an X from an O, but he impressed me right away with his basketball knowledge. You gave him any task and he could organize it and get it done.”

Rob Kennedy, president of the Hoop Group, an organization that runs the gamut of basketball-related activities from instruction to competition to camps to clinics, said Gregory’s ability to adapt to anything basketball related made him a valuable asset. So much so that he served two stints at the Hoop Group in two different capacities.

“Dennis was one of those guys who was well liked by everybody, and obviously throughout the Metropolitan Area he was known by everybody,” said Kennedy. “That combination made him a unique character in the basketball world.”

“He probably wore 20 different hats during his professional career – and they were all basketball hats. He loved doing that.” Kennedy isn’t so sure Gregory, who sought to stay out of the spotlight and was humble to a fault, would be all that gung-ho about a tournament named in his honor, however.

“I’m sure he’s looking down saying ‘What are you guys doing?’” Kennedy said. “At the same time, I’m sure he would be both happy and proud that the tournament is raising money to help kids in North Jersey pursue their basketball dreams. He would have liked that idea a lot.”




